How to boil water

INGREDIENTS

Tap water

EQUIPMENT

→ Pot

WHAT TO DO

- 1. Put water in pot.
- 2. Put pot on stove.
- 3. Turn on heat under pot.
- 4. When water forms vigorous bubbles that break the surface of the water and spatter around a bit (aka "rolling boil"), turn off the stove and serve.
